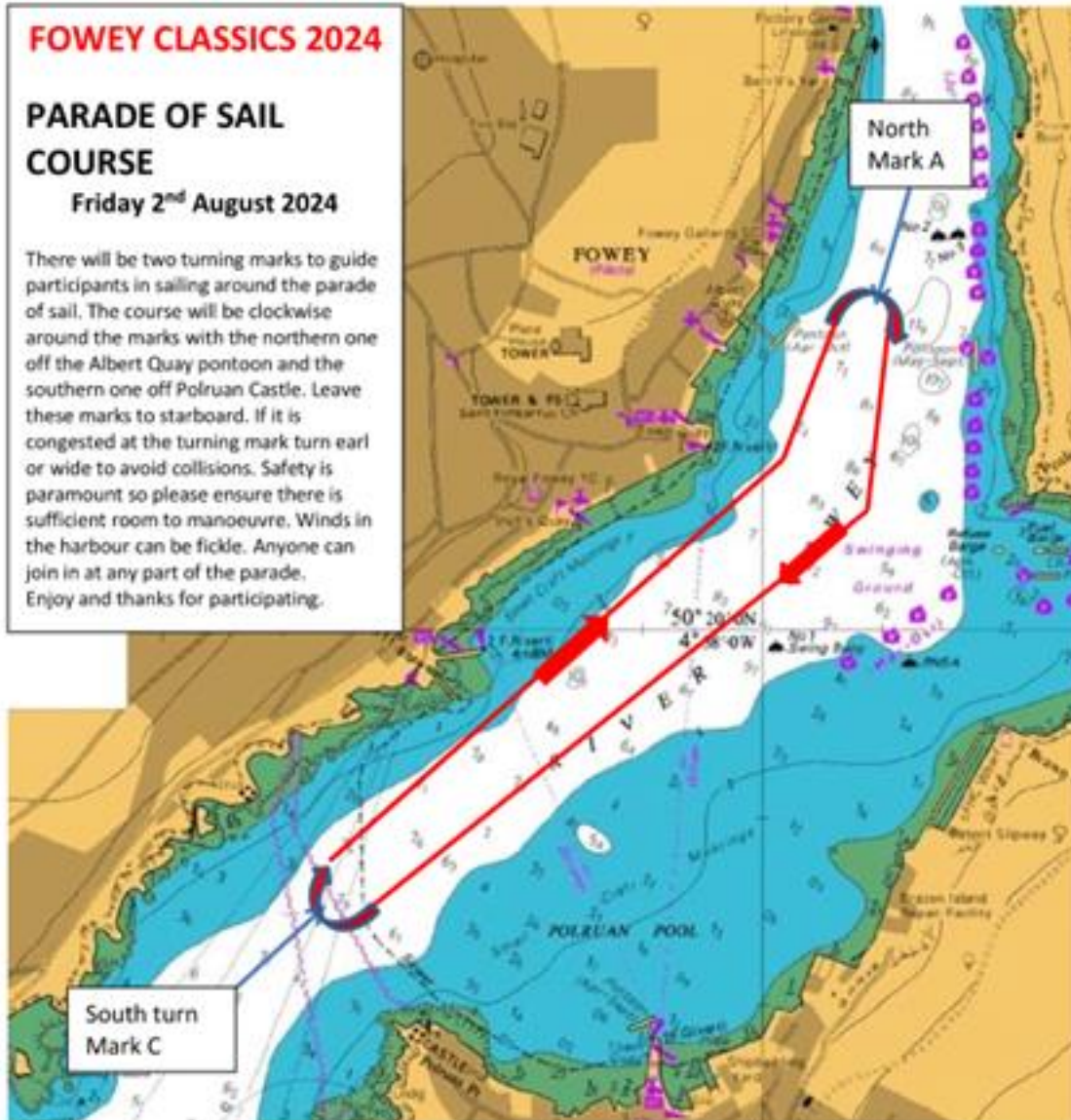


### FOWEY CLASSICS 2024

#### PARADE OF SAIL COURSE

Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2024

There will be two turning marks to guide participants in sailing around the parade of sail. The course will be clockwise around the marks with the northern one off the Albert Quay pontoon and the southern one off Polruan Castle. Leave these marks to starboard. If it is congested at the turning mark turn early or wide to avoid collisions. Safety is paramount so please ensure there is sufficient room to manoeuvre. Winds in the harbour can be fickle. Anyone can join in at any part of the parade. Enjoy and thanks for participating.
